CLOSING SPEECH AT THE FIRST PLENARY SESSION OF THE CHINESE PEOPLE'S POLITICAL CONSULTATIVE CONFERENCE

September 30, 1949

This shows that our cause enjoys the support of our international friends as well as of the people across our country. We extend our heartfelt thanks to them for their good will. We shall certainly not fail them.
