

Several specific regulations of the GAC on strengthening the united front work within government agencies

In order to further strengthen the united front work within government agencies, the GAC and the Government Council, in accordance with the recommendations of the First National Secretary-General's Meeting on this aspect, the following provisions are made:

(1) To approve Secretary-General Li Wei-han's report at the National Secretary-General's Meeting on further strengthening the united front work within government agencies, and the people's governments at all levels should organize staff to study and implement them.

(2) For the united front work within government agencies, the people's governments at or above the province (city) level and their various departments are in charge of the secretary-general or the director of the general office. Appropriate personnel must be designated to be in charge, and full-time or part-time personnel may be set up to assist according to the specific circumstances. People's governments at all levels and heads of departments must be responsible for leading and helping.

(3) The personnel departments of government agencies should closely integrate the united front work in their personnel handling and welfare work.

(4) The secretary-general or director of the general office (or the designated person in charge) of the government agency may, together with the person in charge of the personnel department, convene a symposium on united front work within the agency on a regular or irregular basis, and invite people from all parties and non-party affiliations within the agency as appropriate. And experts and technical personnel to participate in order to understand the situation, deal with problems, more unity and progress.

(5) The learning and leadership organization of government agencies should pay attention to attracting a certain number of activists among the middle and lower-level staff with party affiliation and non-party affiliation to participate.

(6) People's governments at all levels and departments should regularly inspect the united front work within the organs, sum up experience, deal with the problems found in a timely manner, and make a comprehensive report to the superior.
