a telegram to Mao Zedong in the names of Liu Shaoqi, Zhou Enlai and Zhu De: "Today's Politburo meeting, everyone agreed that if the Soviet Union agrees to sign agreements on Port Arthur, loans, aviation and trade now, Comrade Enlai will go to Moscow once. The two agreements have been drafted. The trade agreement can also propose the types and general quantities of goods exported from the Soviet Union and goods imported from the Soviet Union to China. The Minister of Trade can also go to Mao once with Comrade Enlai. In case of bad weather, we have to prepare for a month There is time to take the train back and forth.

But if the Soviet side is not prepared to sign agreements on loans, aviation, and trade now, and is only prepared to issue a statement on the issue of garrisoning troops in Port Arthur and general political issues, then it seems unnecessary for Comrade Enlai to go.
