Liu Shaoqi: "The state-owned economy should exercise leadership over cooperatives by economic means, exercising leadership through relations laid down by contracts and through pricing policies rather than demanding political and legal leadership"

summarizing the experience of the cooperative movement in the liberated areas and the early days of the founding of New China, and expounding the nature, role and policy of running cooperatives. It is pointed out that at present, there are mainly three types of cooperatives that should be organized, namely consumer cooperatives among workers and urban working people, supply and marketing cooperatives among farmers, and handicraft production cooperatives among urban and rural handicraftsmen.
