He strongly objects to the presence of the U.S. 7th Fleet in the Formosan Straits and calls for all nations to unite against American imperialism.

Each nation on Earth should manage its own affairs. Asian affairs should be handled by Asians, not by Americans. US aggression in Asia is certain to arouse widespread and resolute opposition among the peoples of Asia.

The Chinese people, he said, will 'not be seduced by imperialist riches, nor will they be scared by imperialist threats'. Chairman Mao called on 'the people of China and the peoples of the world to unite, to make ample preparations, and to defeat any US imperialist provocation'

Zhou speaks also on Taiwan
