Bo Yibo: [On state budget](#). In his report, Bo Yibo pointed out: The state budget in 1951 was formulated in the context of the massive invasion of North Korea by US imperialism and the encroachment of Taiwan, a territory that directly threatened the security of the Chinese mainland. in which it was made clear that the priority of industrial construction of the first FYP period was to be given to heavy industry and that light industry was to be subordinated. Other sectors could be developed according to actual needs and consideration of whatever personnel or physical resources they had, provided they didn't hinder the development of heavy industry.

After Minister Bo Yibo's report, Vice Chairman Li Jishen, Commissioner Cheng Qian, Commissioner Huang Yanpei, Commissioner Fu Zuoyi, Commissioner Ma Xulun, Commissioner Shen Junru, Commissioner Ma Yinchu, Commissioner Zhang Bojun, Commissioner Guo Moruo, Commissioner Situ Meitang, Commissioner Zhang Zhizhong, Commissioner Xu Teli and Members of the National Committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference, Fu Ding, who were present at the meeting, all spoke in succession, saying that in a short period of two to three years, the financial and economic situation of our country can be fundamentally improved, so as to consolidate national defense, stabilize prices, and fully recover. Construction, they all expressed their gratitude and admiration, and agreed that our country can achieve such great results in all aspects, mainly due to the leadership of Chairman Mao and the Communist Party of China.
