

About recruiting young students and young workers to participate in various

Joint Decision of the Military Cadre School

(Promulgated by the People's Revolutionary Military Commission of the Central People's Government and the GAC on December 1, 1950)

In order to accelerate the development of our national defense, we hereby stipulate the following methods for recruiting young students and young workers to attend various military cadre schools:

(1) The Air Force School, the Naval School, and the various Special Forces Schools under the People's Revolutionary Military Commission will, in the near future, simultaneously recruit students from all over the country. Young students aged 17 to 25, with pure thoughts and good health, and with a junior high school education or above, as well as young workers with a primary school education, may apply to participate.

(2) Provincial, municipal (prefectural) and county governments should, in accordance with the specific instructions of the higher-level governments, incorporate local educational administrative leadership bodies, New Democratic Youth League organizations, student unions, trade unions and other relevant parties to immediately establish a "Military Cadre School Admissions Committee" to be responsible for local admissions work.

(3) Each local Military Cadre School Admissions Committee shall be responsible for designating a Military Cadre School Student Admissions Committee for each of its affiliated schools and factories. This committee shall be composed of members from each school, factory, New Democratic Youth Organization, student union, trade union, and educators' union. It shall be responsible for handling the enrollment procedures for its unit and conducting a preliminary review of the political and physical qualifications of applicants. The lists of students from each school and factory who have registered for the various Military Cadre Schools shall be filed with the school or factory administration and then submitted to the admissions committee of the superior Military Cadre School.

(4) The registration period is from December 10 to January 10, 1951. Other specific procedures will be determined by the local "Military Cadre School Admissions Committee".

(5) All students must apply on a completely voluntary basis. After registration, they must be reviewed and approved by the "Admission Committee" of each school or factory and the "Enrollment Committee" of each region before they can be admitted.

(6) The admission of young students and young workers to various military cadre schools is of great significance to the strengthening of our country's national defense. We hope that all democratic parties, people's organizations and patriotic people from all walks of life across the country will give their full assistance.
