

The instructions of the Ministry of Justice of the Northeast People's Government on the implementation of the Three Antis Movement

Date: 1951-10-17

People's courts of Northeast provinces, cities, counties, and banners:

Under the leadership of the party and the government, the campaign against corruption and bureaucracy has been widely launched in all organs and departments in the northeast and is now underway. In order to make this movement, especially in our judiciary, more well carried out and implemented, the Ministry hereby instructs the following instructions:

1. Courts at all levels must resolutely implement and implement the spirit of Chairman Gao Gang's report in handling corruption cases, and must not be accommodating. According to the specific circumstances of the case, open trials should be used to carry out trials to expand publicity on the rule of law. For cases of greater educational significance, they should be reported to the Northeast Branch of the Supreme People's Court so that the review and arraignment can expand the impact.

2. In this movement, courts at all levels should conduct serious and thorough inspections of all staff in the court (including miscellaneous people) with a firm attitude and a spirit of responsibility. And the inspection process and its results, after the end of the campaign, quickly summarize and report to the headquarters.
